1 General information and accounting policies

Statement of compliance

Beresford Street Kitchen Limited is a limited liability company incorporated in Jersey with exclusively charitable objects. The registered office is 17 Beresford Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 4WN

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102, the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland ("FRS 102") and in accordance with Jersey Company Law 1991.

Basis of preparation and change in accounting policy

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards. The financial statements are prepared in sterling which is the functional currency of Beresford Street Kitchen Limited ("the Company").

Expenses

Expenses are recognised on an accurals basis. The Company has a 21 year contract lease of 17 Beresford Street passed before the Royal Court on 23rd October 2015 and no rent is charged for use of the freehold premise occupied by the company.

Tangible fixed assets

Tangible fixed asset are stated at their purchase cost including any incidental costs of acquisition, except those included in donations in kind and less accumulated depreciation and impairment. Depreciation is calculated to write off the costs less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life at the following rates:

Going concern

The company relies on income from its trading activites and donations to meet the running costs each year.

Cash flow projections have been used when considering the going concern status of the Company and these projections are partly subject to successful grant applications. If any of these were to fail the directors would pursue alternative sources of funding to avoid any negative impact on the Company's going concern status. It is the view of the directors that the Company has sufficent cash reserves to operate subject to the income expected being received therefore these financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis.

Donations in kind
